WATERCOLOR REQUIREMENTS FOR CNYWS EXHIBITS

All work must be original. No reproductions will be accepted. Works done at a workshop or under the supervision of an instructor are not eligible. Paintings done from published photos or reference work that is not the creation of the artist are not eligible. Paintings shown at previous CNWS exhibits are not accepted. All paintings must be in water-soluble media on paper, matted with white or off-white mat and glazed with Plexiglas or glass. If double matted, thin colored liners are not acceptable. Water-soluble media include: transparent or opaque watercolor, casein, gouache, egg tempera, and acrylic painted in an aqueous manner. A limited use of pastel, collage or ink, not constituting more than 10% of the painting is allowed. We encourage our Signature members to exhibit in our two Signature shows and all members to participate in our juried show.
